- Plastic Clean plastic bottles
- Glass Clean and empty bottles and jars (no lids) NO broken glass
- Aluminium clean: cans, clean foil, foil trays
- Steel Clean cans tins and aerosol sprays (caps removed)

WHAT NOT TO PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING

- Greenwaste Grass clippings, garden cuttings, leaves and soil
- Household products clothing, toys, rubber, leather, crockery, ceramics
- · Electrical goods Computers, mobiles, TVs etc
- Steel products (except steel cans)
- Food scraps or wrappings
- Nappies
- · Oil, acid or chemicals
- Needles and Syringes
- Styrofoam and polystyrene
- Timber or building materials
- Batteries and metal
