- Express their feelings and opinions assertively.
- Relax and have fun in an inclusive and friendly space.
- Feel secure and safe in a supportive environment.
- Expect that Lake Grace Youth Centre rules are fair, consistently implemented and respect the rights of all involved.
- Be valued for their individuality including that of race, gender, culture, age, physical or intellectual diversity.

# To support these rights I agree to:

- Make all people feel welcome and ask them to join in activities, or be part of my group.
- Treat others with courtesy, kindness and respect.
- Listen to other people and try to understand their points of view.
- Talk and discuss instead of yelling and arguing.
- Be helpful to other members and co-operate with Youth Centre staff and volunteers.
- Watch out for others to ensure everyone is safe and secure.
- Be responsible for my own actions.
- Value others for their individual differences.
- Respect other's property and those of the Shire of Lake and the Lake Grace Youth Centre.
- Agree to the Lake Grace Youth Centre rules.

#### **Lake Grace Youth Centre Rules**

As someone attending the Lake Grace Youth Centre programs and activities I will:

- Follow the directions of the Shire of Lake Grace Youth Centre staff or volunteers.
- Respect the Youth Centre and its property.
- Treat all others as I would like to be treated.

### I will not

- Be mean to people, call them names, put them down, spread rumours about them or do anything else which I know would make them uncomfortable or would upset them.
- Use racist or sexist language, or insult people on the basis of their religion, sexual orientation, physical or intellectual disability or physical appearance.

- Use violent or aggressive behaviour hitting, punching, kicking, scratching, tripping, spitting, or by any other way.
- Threaten to hurt anyone
- Bring weapons of any kind into the Youth Centre and its programs.
- Deliberately damage any property including tagging, scratching and other forms of vandalism.
- Touch or take any property that does not belong to me unless I have permission from the owner.
- Bring alcohol or any other illicit substances into the Youth Centre or on any of its programs.
- Be under the influence of any substances. If I am, I will be asked to leave and if I refuse the police may be called.

# Behaviour and consequences

Misbehaviour will be dealt with using a warning system. Usually there will be 3 warnings given. On the third warning, my parent/guardian will be contacted and I will be asked to leave the Youth Centre. Upon being asked to leave, I may be given a ban for a specific period of time depending on the severity of the incident and at the discretion of the Youth Centre staff or volunteers. The warning level may also be automatically escalated depending on the severity of the breach.

#### **Member Declaration**

# INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

#### Cancellation

If the Youth Centre, for any unforeseen circumstances needs to cancel, we will contact you as soon as possible to inform you. You will also be notified of any rescheduling.

# **Behaviour and consequences**

#### **Rules**

To be a member of the Youth Centre we expect you to follow the rules below:

- No bullying of any kind
- No swearing
- No racist or sexist language
- No verbal abuse or threats to peers, staff or volunteers.
- No fighting or aggressive behaviour
- No weapons or illegal items are to be brought into the centre or any program
- No deliberate damage to any property
- No stealing

Members are expected to treat staff, volunteers, equipment and each other with respect and kindness at all times.
