## Shire of Lake Grace Road Network

---

With Harvest fast approaching all roads users are asked to exercise caution on our road network as debris and water may still lying on roads.

Many useable roads are still subject to damage including shoulder scouring, soft edges with only single lane use.

Areas to the South-East of Newdegate and South of Lake King are still affected by water.

All vehicles greater than 4.5t are restricted to a maximum speed of 80km/hr on all unsealed roads within the Shire of Lake Grace for the period 01/11/2017 to 31/12/2017 inclusive.

It is anticipated that the Flood Event repair works will commence from mid-November.

We urge everyone to be alert and considerate of other road users.
