## CEO's Corner

### Flooding Event – February 2017

The Shire of Lake Grace received notification from Main Roads WA (MRWA) on Friday 9 June 2017 that our Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements cost estimate of \$10,607,882 for AGRN 743 based on the use of contractors for the re-instatement works for the local roads has been approved.

Our first step is now to engage a Project Manager; it is proposed that this position will be sourced from the WA Local Government Association (WALGA) preferred supplier panel. After which, the Project Manager will then call the required tenders on behalf of the Shire for Supervision Services, Plant, Equipment and Materials as required.

These tendering processes are required to ensure we are compliant with the provisions of the Local Government Act. It is estimated that the timeframe to undertake these processes is a minimum of six weeks.

### AGRN 743 Category C Recovery Grants

Primary producers that have suffered direct damage as a result of the flooding in the Shire's of Lake Grace and Ravensthorpe are eligible for a grant of up to \$10,000 and for those in the City of Swan the grant is up to \$25,000. This grant is to cover costs incurred for the clean-up and immediate restoration as a result of the damage. The grants will not cover loss of income.

This assistance is managed by the Department of Agriculture and Food (DAFWA). All claims for Category C Recovery Grants must be lodged with DAFWA before 4 December 2017. Claims which are incomplete or are lodged after this date will not be accepted.

### Building and Maintenance Team

This fortnight, Wayne Trawinski, the Shire's Building and Maintenance Supervisor reports that works are continuing on the Lake Grace Independent Living Units as follows:

- Gyprocking has been completed on all units;
- Cabinetry installation underway on units 1 and 2;

- Retaining walls installed; and,
- Preparation works for paving, driveways and crossovers have commenced.

Over the past fortnight maintenance requests have been completed for:

- Newdegate Pavilion - replacement and repairs to doors, fascia and eaves; and painting of fascia and eaves;
- Lake Grace AIM Hospital Museum – painting around veranda;
- Lake King Pavilion – made building secure to prevent break ins;
- Lake Grace Airstrip – adjustments made to the roller door on the building; and,
- Lake Grace Medical Centre – removed shelving.

### Road Works

Our Construction Team have returned to Hatters Hill Road to carry out trimming works to meet road width specifications and installation of culverts.

The Newdegate contract grader has been working on Witham Road, Dragon Rocks Road, Edwards Road, Biddy Camm Road and North Newdegate Road and will move on to Aylmore Road.

The Lake King contract grader has been working on Smith Road, Mulcahy Road, Broombush Flat Road and will move on to Winchcombe Road.

### Road Maintenance

The maintenance team has been patching North Lake Grace-Karlgarin Road and has carried out slashing on the road verge at the Kulin-Lake Grace and North Lake Grace-Karlgarin Road intersection. The team has assisted with pushing up rubbish at the Lake Grace tip while the landfill caretaker has been away and have put road traffic counters out within the Shire.

### Parks and Gardens

The town maintenance crew have been out to Lake King to carry out works around the cemetery, public toilets and park behind the Tavern. Works have been carried out around the Sports Pavilion and Hall in Lake King. The team have tidied up around the playgrounds, main street and street trees in the Lake Grace townsite. Spraying of weeds has been carried out around at the saleyards and laneways within the Lake Grace townsite.
