# Highlights from Council

Highlights from the 24 April Council Meeting:

- Council approved the transfer of surplus funds from a road job on Mallee Hill Rd to intersection repairs as a result of vandalism damage to the newly sealed intersection. This was necessary works, the cost of which could have been better spent elsewhere.
- Michelle Slarke and Suzanne
  Reeves gave a presentation on the
  outcomes of the Lake Grace
  Bushcare Project, which saw tree
  plantings over a number of sites
  around town.
- Council appointed Mr Kevin Penny as a community representative for Lake King on the Shire of Lake Grace Tourism Advisory Committee.
- Council endorsed and adopted the Business Continuity Plan and IT Disaster Recovery Plan for the Shire.
- Council authorised the CEO to give public notice of the Business Plan for a Major Trading Undertaking for the Shire of Lake Grace to provide housing for the WA Country Health Service and the Lake Grace Hospital.

The Business Plan is available for viewing at the Shire office or on our website, and is open for comment until 5 June 2024.

From the Chief Executive Officer continued

Craig Elefsen, Manager of Infrastructure, and myself attended a 3 day workshop in Bunbury recently, which was run by MainRoads WA and representatives from the University of South Australia as part of the Local Government Road Safety Vanguards Programme.

The focus was on improving road safety systems rather than apportioning blame on drivers. Examples of both poor and well-designed roads were discussed in detail with the aim to improve road safety.

The Stubbs St/ South Rd intersection was the subject of some discussion with no real solution being presented, however I believe that one of the MainRoads designers may be undertaking a bit more research in the case.

Whilst the focus was on improving road systems, it was obvious that proven measures such as side line markings and wider sealed shoulders are still a long way off being the norm given current road funding.

# Waste Management

A recent review of waste management operations within the Shire highlighted the need for improvement in the sorting and off-loading of waste according to its type.

The Shire operates four tips near the towns of Lake Grace, Newdegate, Lake King, and Varley. The Lake King and Varley tips are unmanned and open all year round.

The Lake Grace and Newdegate tips are manned, and it is at these sites where the public are to be mindful of the designated areas for different types of waste.

#### PLEASE REMEMBER:

- prior to disposing of waste at a tip, you must separate your waste by type.
- when entering a manned tip, you must stop at the tip attendant's shed to allow the attendant to record the volumes being accepted.
- off loading of waste is the responsibility of the disposer. The attendant is not permitted to help you off-load any waste.
- aggressive and abusive behaviour towards any attendant will not be tolerated.
- asbestos disposal requires a permit, and may only be disposed of at Lake Grace. At the time of disposal, you must show a signed Asbestos Disposal Permit to the attendant. Refer to the Shire's website for details.
- access is prohibited outside of opening hours at Lake Grace and Newdegate tip sites.
- E-waste is no longer accepted in kerbside bins or at tips. The location of the nearest drop point can be found at: https://recycleright.wa.gov.au/find-my-nearest/
