Highlights from the 24 July Council Meeting:

- Council endorsed the 4WDL
 Keyworker Housing Business Case.
 This is a project to try and obtain funding to help offset development costs involved with building and supplying homes in our towns for all members of the workforce.
- A new member was appointed to the Shire of Lake Grace Tourism Advisory Committee. We welcome Mr Norm O'Neill, a passionate supporter of the Pingaring area.
- Negotiations continued for the purchase of some land for the purpose of general industry, which is much needed in Lake Grace.

We would like to remind the community that there is a STOP sign at the intersections of Stubbs St, South Rd and Kulin-Lake Grace Rd. It's disappointing to see locals also ignoring the road rules at this notorious intersection.

From the Chief Executive Officer

The main focus this past month has been on completing the Shire Budget for 2024/2025. This is now in the final stages and it is anticipated that it will be formally adopted by council at a Special Meeting of Council on 31 July.

Several meetings have been held with the Wheatbelt Development Commission and related parties regarding options for housing in Lake Grace and the development of a Wheatbelt Housing Pilot submission with nine other Councils. We have several irons in the fire for grant funding to fund the headworks development of vacant Shire land on the east end of town.

Excitement is building for the finalisation of the Pump Track next to the All Abilities playground in Lake Grace. The guys constructing the track have put on a few impromptu performances over the past week. It is good to know that it has been constructed by the experts, with one of the guys being a state champion in the sport. There is still landscaping to be done before it can be open to the public.

An item on TV a few weeks back about the Ravensthorpe versus Hopetoun Football, and winter sports, highlighted the contribution supplied by the Lake King community. We will use this in our submission to a possible new funding source, recently identified for the Lake King Sports Pavilion redevelopment.
